Curriculum

Our value is Kindness, and our Enquiry question is 'How are we looking after our planet for future generations?' In Class 1, the children will discover the five oceans of the world. Class 2 children will compare the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole. Class 3 will look at the devastation of flooding near and far. Class 4 are continuing their historical enquiry exploring the rise and fall of the Berlin Wall as Year 6 prepare for their SATs.



National Assessments

Over this term and into the next, there are several national statutory assessments for many of our children including: a Phonics Screening Check for Year One; the KS1 SATs for year Two; the Multiplication Check for Year Four and the KS2 SATs for the Year Six children. All the preparation and tests will be carried out appropriately and sensitively and we appreciate everybody's effort and support to help the children achieve their best.

Field

Now that the weather has improved, the children are all delighted that we are able to use the back field more consistently. It is an excellent natural space which we always try to use and develop as much as possible.



Marathon Challenge

Next week, the school has been invited to take part in an official Guinness World Record which is 'The most pledges received for an exercise campaign in one month'. The current record is 241,675 people. We will be asking the children to firstly pledge to take part and then run, jog or wheel one mile on Wednesday as a whole school together. It will be a great opportunity to come together as a tribe and promote the Deli Farm run, which isn't too far away.





A Gentle Request

A gentle request about bringing dogs to the school gate during pickups and drop offs. We understand the bond between families and their pets, but we must prioritise the safety, well-being, and accessibility for all members of our school community. Some children may feel anxious or fearful around dogs, which can cause unnecessary stress during pick-up. Even the friendliest dog can become overwhelmed which may lead to unpredictable behaviour.
